## Scholarships for Physics 50195, Special Topics in Physics:

Experiencing the Foundations of Physics: Addressing Academic Content Standards with an Inquiry-Based Approach

July 11 - 15, 2005

All applicants for the course will automatically be considered for scholarship support. The scholarship consists of two parts, (1) Tuition payment, (2) Professional Development support. No separate application is required for the scholarships.

- 1. Tuition will be provided as a payment made at the time the student registers for the course. This payment provides only for the tuition for the course. If there are additional fees charged for processing, application or other Kent State University fees, those will be the responsibility of the student. In order for the tuition to be applied a the time of registration, your application must be approved three weeks in advance. If not approved in advance, tuition will be reimbursed.
- 2. The amount of \$400 is being made available for each student accepted into this course who meets the criteria of being a current science teacher. These money will be provided directly to the course participants upon completion with the expectation that such moneys are to be used for professional expenses related to science teaching.

Return application to address at the bottom of the form. Use additional sheets if needed. The selection committee will notify applicants of acceptance by mail within two weeks of receipt. When accepted, you will also receive instructions for *registering for this course*.
